

RESOLUTION NO. 124-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH SAMSARA NETWORKS, INC. FOR EQUIPMENT, PRODUCTS, OR SERVICES; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS AND OR RENEWALS AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach ("City") is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming, and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, City requires fleet management technologies with related software solutions; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell entered an Agreement with Samsara Networks, Inc. ("Contractor") pursuant to Sourcewell Contract No. 020221-SAM for equipment, products, or services; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to obtain fleet management technologies with related software solutions from Contractor under the same terms, conditions, and pricing provided under Sourcewell Contract No. 020221-SAM; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves the Agreement between the City and Contractor, which is attached to this resolution as Exhibit "A"


Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and or renewals and take any and all actions necessary to effectuate this agreement.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


