RESOLUTION NO. 189-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF PROPERTY INSURANCE, EXCESS LIABILITY INSURANCE, AND EXCESS WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE FROM PREFERRED GOVERNMENTAL INSURANCE TRUST; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (City) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming, and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City requires property, excess liability, and excess workers' compensation insurance policies; and

WHEREAS, the City's broker, Relation Insurance Services of Florida, Inc. (Broker), presented a renewal proposal from Preferred Governmental Insurance Trust (PGIT) for property, excess liability, and excess workers' compensation insurance policies to City staff; and

WHEREAS, based on the various quote options, the Broker and staff concur that PGIT provides the most cost-effective and service-driven option for all insurance policies; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with PGIT for property, excess liability, and excess workers' compensation insurance policies; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.
- <u>Section 2.</u> The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with Preferred Governmental Insurance Trust for property, excess liability, and excess workers' compensation insurance policies and take any other actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.
 - <u>Section 3.</u> This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
