

RESOLUTION NO. 149-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH TOWN OF GULF STREAM FOR POLICE COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO AND TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (City) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach entered into existing agreement to provide Police communications services to the Town of Gulf Stream in 2017; and

WHEREAS, the agreement expires September 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a new agreement with the Town of Highland Beach to continue providing Police communications services, which will commence on October 1, 2022 and expire on September 30, 2027; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves this Agreement between the City and Town of Gulf Stream.

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments thereto and take any other actions necessary to effectuate this Agreement.

Section 4. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
