

RESOLUTION NO. 06-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH MOTPLANS.COM, LLC, FOR BARRICADES, FLASHERS, AND RELATED ITEMS UTILIZING THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE INVITATION TO BID NUMBER 203-3; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (the "City") is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming, and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City requires barricades, flashers, and related items; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale issued Invitation to Bid ("ITB") No. 203-3 to obtain barricades, flashers, and related items; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with ITB No. 203-3, the City of Fort Lauderdale entered into an agreement with MOTPlans.com, LLC (the "Contractor"); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with the Contractor utilizing City of Fort Lauderdale ITB No. 203-3 (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves the Agreement between the City and the Contractor, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A".

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and take any action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
