MASTER CONTRACTOR/SERVICES AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City desires to procure a web-based individual driver record check services; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to procure these goods and services from Contractor utilizing existing contract prices provided to Orange County, Florida, pursuant to its Invitation to Bid No. Y24-105; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Invitation to Bid Y24-105, Orange County, Florida entered into a two (2) year Agreement with Contractor for web-based individual driver record check services effective January 1, 2024, through December 31, 2026, with the option to renew for two (2) additional one (1) year periods; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to procure web-based individual driver record check services from Contractor on the same terms, conditions, and pricing provided under Orange County Contract Y24-105, subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, the City's Purchasing ordinance, and Florida Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein and other good and valuable consideration of which the parties hereto acknowledge, the parties agree as follows:

- The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. The Contractor shall provide web-based individual driver record check services in accordance with and pursuant to the same terms, conditions, and pricing of Contract Y24-105 procured by Orange County in accordance with the Contractor's Price Proposal Summary attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"**.
- 3. This agreement shall terminate on December 31, 2026, unless Contract Y24-105 is renewed or otherwise properly extended by Orange County. If Contract No. Y24-105 is renewed o otherwise properly extended, this Agreement will automatically renew or extend for the same term.
- 4. The City, at its sole discretion reserves the right to terminate this Agreement with or without cause immediately upon providing written notice to Contractor. Upon receipt of such notice, the Contractor shall not incur any additional costs under the Agreement. The City shall be liable only for the reasonable costs incurred by Contractor prior to the date of the notice of termination. The City shall be the sole judge of "reasonable costs."

- 5. The Contractor certifies that the price and rate represent the lowest price and rate for the products and services of any contract between the Contractor and any other governmental entity within the State of Florida.
- 6. To the extent allowed by Fla. Stat. 725.08, the Contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless the City and its officers, employees, agents, and instrumentalities from any and all liability, losses or damages, including attorney's fees and costs of defense, which the City or its officers, employees, agents, or instrumentalities may incur as a result of claims, demands, suits, causes of actions, or proceedings of any kind or nature arising out of, relating to, or resulting from the performance of the agreement by the Contractor or its employees, agents, servants, partners, principals, or subcontractors. To the extent allowed by Fla. Stat. 725.08, the Contractor shall pay all claims and losses in connection therewith, and shall investigate and defend all claims, suits, or actions of any kind or nature in the name of the City, where applicable, including appellate proceedings, and shall pay all costs, judgments, and attorney's fees which may be incurred thereon. The Contractor expressly understands and agrees that any insurance protection required by this Agreement or otherwise provided by the Contractor shall in no way limit the responsibility to indemnify, keep and save harmless, and defend the City or its officers, employees, agents, and instrumentalities as herein provided the obligations of this section shall survive the term of this Agreement.
- 7. Whenever either Party desires to give notice to the other, such notice must be in writing, sent by certified United States Mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested, or sent by commercial express carrier with acknowledgment of delivery, or by hand delivery with a request for a written receipt of acknowledgment of delivery, addressed to the party for whom it is intended at the place last specified. The place for giving notice shall remain the same as set forth herein until changed in writing in the manner provided in this section. For the present, the Parties designate the following:

8. Neither this Agreement nor any right or interest herein shall be assigned, transferred, or encumbered without the written consent of the other Party.

- 9. This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the City of Delray Beach's Code of Ordinances and the laws of the State of Florida. Any dispute relating to this Agreement shall only be filed in a court of competent jurisdiction in Palm Beach County, Florida, and each of the parties to this Agreement submits itself to the jurisdiction of such court. It is hereby understood and agreed that in the event any lawsuit in the judicial system, federal or state, is brought to enforce compliance with this contract or interpret same, or if any administrative proceeding is brought for the same purposes, each party shall pay their own attorney's fees and costs, including appellate fees and costs.
- 10. IF THE CONTRACTOR HAS QUESTIONS REGARDING THE APPLICATION OF CHAPTER 119, FLORIDA STATUTES, TO THE CONTRACTOR'S DUTY TO PROVIDE PUBLIC RECORDS RELATING TO THIS AGREEMENT, CONTACT THE CUSTODIAN OF PUBLIC RECORDS AT CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, CITY CLERK, 100 N.W. 1ST AVE., DELRAY BEACH FLORIDA. THE CITY CLERK'S OFFICE MAY BE CONTACTED BY PHONE AT 561-243-7050 OR VIA EMAIL AT CITYCLERK@MYDELRAYBEACH.COM.
 - a. Contractor shall comply with public records laws, specifically to:
 - i. Keep and maintain public records required by the City to perform the service.
 - ii. Upon request from the City's custodian of public records, provide the City with a copy of the requested records or allow the records to be inspected or copied within a reasonable time at a cost that does not exceed the cost provided in Florida Statute or as otherwise provided by law.
 - iii. Ensure that public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements are not disclosed except as authorized by law for the duration of the Agreement term and following completion of the Agreement if the Contractor does not transfer the records to the City.
 - iv. Upon completion of the Agreement, transfer, at no cost, to the City all public records in possession of the Contractor or keep and maintain public records required by the City to perform the service. If the Contractor transfers all public records to the City upon completion of the Agreement, the Contractor shall destroy any duplicate public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements. If the Contractor keeps and maintains public records upon completion of the Agreement, the Contractor shall meet all applicable requirements for retaining public records. All records stored electronically must be provided to the City, upon request from the City's custodian of public records, in a format that is compatible with the information technology systems of the City.
 - v. If the Contractor does not comply with this section, the City shall enforce the

contract provisions in accordance with the contract and may unilaterally cancel this contract in accordance with state law.

- 11. Contractor is aware that the Inspector General of Palm Beach County has the authority to investigate and audit matters relating to the negotiation and performance of this contract and may demand and obtain records and testimony from Contractor and its subcontractors and lower tier subcontractors. Contractor understands and agrees that in addition to all other remedies and consequences provided by law, the failure of Contractor or its subcontractors and lower tier subcontractors to fully cooperate with the Inspector General when requested may be deemed by the City to be a material breach of this Agreement justifying its termination.
- 12. The continuation of this Agreement beyond the end of any fiscal year shall be subject to both the appropriation and the availability of funds in accordance with Florida law.
- with the provisions of Section 448.095, Fla. Stat., "Employment Eligibility." Contractor affirms and represents it is registered with the E-Verify system, utilizing same, and will continue to utilize same as required by law. Compliance with this section includes, but is not limited to, utilization of the E-Verify System to verify the work authorization status of all newly hired employees and requiring all subcontractors to provide an affidavit attesting that the subcontractor does not employ, contract with, or subcontract with, an unauthorized alien. Failure to comply with this section will result in the termination of this Agreement, or if your subcontractor knowingly violates the statute, the subcontract must be terminated immediately. Any challenge to termination under this provision must be filed in the Circuit Court no later than 20 calendar days after the date of termination. If terminated for a violation of the statute by Contractor, the Contractor may be prohibited from conducting future business with the City or awarded a solicitation or contract for a period of 1 year after the date of termination. All costs incurred to initiate and sustain the aforementioned programs shall be the responsibility of the Contractor.
 - 14. Contractor shall provide insurance in accordance with Exhibit "B" attached hereto.
- 15. The documents listed below are a part of this Agreement and are hereby incorporated by reference. In the event of inconsistency between the documents, unless otherwise provided herein, the terms of the following documents will govern in the following order of precedence:
 - a. Terms and conditions as contained in this Agreement.
 - b. Terms and Conditions of Contract No. Y24-105.
 - c. Contactor's response to Solicitation ITB No. Y24-105 Web Based Individual Driver Record Checks Services and any subsequent information submitted by Contractor during the evaluation and negotiation process.

EXHIBIT "B"

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

The required insurance coverage is to be issued by an insurance company authorized, licensed and registered to do business in the State of Florida, with the minimum rating of B+ or better, in accordance with the latest edition of A.M. Best's Insurance Guide. This insurance shall be documented in certificates of insurance which provides that the City of Delray Beach shall be notified at least thirty (30) days in advance of cancellation, non-renewal, or adverse change. The receipt of certificates or other documentation of insurance or policies or copies of policies by the City or by any of its representatives, which indicate less coverage than is required, does not constitute a waiver of Firm's obligation to fulfill the insurance requirements herein. Deductibles must be acceptable to the City of Delray Beach.

Firm shall provide insurance coverage as follows:

- 1. Workers' Compensation Insurance as required by law.
- 2. Employer's Liability Insurance \$100,000 per occurrence, \$100,000 for each disease, and \$500,000 for aggregate disease
- 3. Comprehensive General Liability Insurance with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 in the aggregate for Bodily Injury and Property Damage.
- Automobile Liability Insurance for owned, non-owned and hired vehicles with a limit of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence, combined single limit for Bodily Injury Liability and Property Damage Liability.
- 5. Professional Liability Insurance with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence.
- Network Security & Data Breach Liability- with a limit of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence/claim

All renewal or replacement certificates of insurance shall be forwarded to the City Purchasing Department located at 100 N.W. 1st Ave., Delray Beach, FL 33444.
