

RESOLUTION NO. 70-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT TO RETAIN KIEWIT INFRASTRUCTURE SOUTH CO., AS THE CONSTRUCTION MANAGER AT RISK FOR THE NORTHWEST NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT PURSUANT TO RFQ 2025-013; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS AND/OR RENEWALS THERETO AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (“City”) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming, and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to retain a Construction Manager at Risk for the Northwest Neighborhood Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with Kiewit Infrastructure South Co., (“Contractor”) for the aforementioned services for the Northwest Neighborhood Improvements Project pursuant to Request for Qualifications No. 2025-013 (the “Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves this Agreement between the City and Contractor, which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit “A”.

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and/or renewals and take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
