








### **HISTORY**

### 111 YEARS OF LIBRARY INFORMATION SERVICES IN DELRAY BEACH



The Ladies Improvement Association founded the Delray Beach Public Library in 1913.

In 1938 the Delray Beach Public Library Association became a not-for-profit corporation to provide a public library in Delray Beach.

Since 1950, our patrons have received library service through a successful public/private partnership between the City of Delray Beach and the Library Association.

In 2006 the Library moved to its current location on Atlantic Avenue.

### FLORIDA LIBRARY FUNDING

In 1967 the PBC Taxing district was created. Delray Beach is exempt because they use city tax dollars to pay for a library.

The current Palm Beach County taxing millage rate is 0.5491.

If Delray Beach did not support a library in Delray, the additional taxes would be \$9 million.

### CONCLUSION

Instead of being a burden on taxpayers, the Delray Library reduces the burden on taxpayers.




