**WHEREAS**, the safety and effectiveness of emergency responders depend on the quality and accuracy of information obtained by Public Safety Telecommunicators at the City of Delray Beach Police Department's Emergency Communications Center; and

**WHEREAS**, these professionals serve as a vital link for law enforcement, relaying essential information, monitoring activities through radio and computer systems, and ensuring the safety of police officers; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Safety Telecommunicators of the Delray Beach Police Department work tirelessly, 24/7, demonstrating exceptional skill, professionalism, and dedication in handling emergencies, apprehending criminals, and safeguarding residents, visitors, and travelers alike; and

**WHEREAS**, since 1991, Congress has designated the second full week of April as National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week to recognize and honor their invaluable contributions to public safety:
