Re: 2nd Quarter Narrative Update

Dear Joan:

Below is an update for The Center for Technology, Enterprise, and Development Delray Beach CRA Grant Programs.

Our purpose is to provide business assistance for Youth and Adults in the CRA/City of Delray Beach targeted communities.

We provided a wide range of programs and services designed to assist individuals to obtain financial independence, such as our;

- Youth Entrepreneurship Program that trains Youth in the skills of starting a business and imparts to them an entrepreneurial mindset for life;
 - 1. enhance the academic learning and literacy of inner-city youth.
 - 2. create youth businesses in the targeted area
 - 3. enhance the learning environment

2nd Quarter

- 1. marketed to local schools and community organizations to recruit and identify youth that are interested in entrepreneurship. To date, we have identified 15 youth that live in the targeted area who are entrepreneurial minded.
- 2. Conducted an Orientation to let them know what's expected of them and benefits of being in the program.
- 3. Conducted 2 workshops on starting and the importance of a Business Plan and Business Credit.
- Professionals are asked to volunteer to share their experience of business Startup.

GOAL: To complete the 1st Group by July 15th and start 2nd group the 3rd week of July.

- Government Contract Training is designed to prepare...
 - 1. Small business owners with the knowledge to prepare responses to proposals
 - 2. To guide small businesses in obtaining the necessary permits, licenses and certifications per business classifications so they are work "ready"
 - 3. Small business owners with the tools to search for opportunities, identify and procedures to submit responses.

2nd Quarter

- 1. Conducted a workshop (with an Attorney) on the appropriate structure for business registrations based on types of products and services offered.
- 2. Three workshops are scheduled during the month of May to provide detailed knowledge on terms & definitions used in RFP's and RFQ's. In addition, how to locate potential opportunities, how to respond and track the status. In June, a workshop will be held on completing capability statements.

 - 3. To insure qualified businesses are available and represented within the selection pool

2nd Quarter

- 1. A hands-on workshop was held to complete applications for vendor registration in SAM.gov and the State of Florida.
- 2. The workshop provided hands-on support to completing and submitting woman owned, minority owned and small business certification with the State of Florida
- 3. Additional workshops will be held during the month of June to address those who still need to complete registrations and certifications.
- 4. A "directory" will be created from this process
