RESOLUTION 171-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THREE AGREEMENTS WITH FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY FOR THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF DECORATIVE LIGHTS AND POLES FOR THE GEORGE BUSH BOULEVARD PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO AND TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THESE AGREEMENTS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (City) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City requires services for the purchase, installation, and maintenance of 93 decorative lights and poles along George Bush Boulevard between NE 2nd Avenue and SR-A1A; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to obtain these services from Florida Power & Light Company (FP&L); and

WHEREAS, the purchase and installation of these decorative lights and poles is split between three phases requiring three separate agreements; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Section 1.</u> That the foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.
- <u>Section 2.</u> The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and approves the three agreements between the City and FP&L, attached to this Resolution as collective Exhibit "A".
- <u>Section 3.</u> The City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments thereto and take any other actions necessary to effectuate these Agreements.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
