

RESOLUTION NO. 178-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A PURCHASE ORDER TO REP SERVICES, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A SHADE STRUCTURE AT BARWICK PARK; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE PURCHASE ORDER; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (City) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City requires playground and related equipment; and

WHEREAS, on February 9, 2021, the City entered into an Agreement with REP Services, Inc. to utilize contract prices provided to Clay County pursuant to its Solicitation RFP No. 18/19-2 ("the Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, on July 13, 2021, the City Commission approved additional funding to be authorized by purchase order by the City Manager; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to issue a purchase order to REP Services, Inc. to obtain a shade structure and installation services at Barwick Park utilizing the prices authorized under the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby authorizes issuance of a purchase order to REP Services, Inc., pursuant to the quotation dated October 25, 2021, which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit "A".

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the purchase order.

Section 4. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
