A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE EARLY LEARNING COALITION OF PALM BEACH COUNTY SETTING FORTH THE OBLIGATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CHILDREN'S SERVICES COUNCIL OF PALM BEACH SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS AND TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (City) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming, and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City provides afterschool programs at the Pompey Park Community Center and Delray Beach Community Center; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to obtain a scholarship program for these afterschool programs; and

WHEREAS, in order for the City to participate in the Children's Services Council of Palm Beach Scholarship Program, the City must enter into a State of Florida Statewide School Readiness Provider Contract with the Early Learning Coalition of Palm Beach County, setting forth the obligations of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Section 1.</u> The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.
- <u>Section 2.</u> The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves this State of Florida Statewide School Readiness Provider Contract between the City and the Early Learning Coalition of Palm Beach County, which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit "A".
- <u>Section 3.</u> The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and take any and all actions necessary to effectuate this Agreement.
 - Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
