Traffic Performance Standards (TPS) Review

The Palm Beach County Traffic Division has reviewed the above referenced project Traffic Impact Statement, dated April 15, 2022, pursuant to the Traffic Performance Standards in Article 12 of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code (ULDC). The project is summarized as follows:

Municipality: Delray Beach

Location: SWC of Atlantic Ave and Military Trail **PCN:** 12-42-46-14-24-001-0000/-002-0000

Access: As existing (one right-in/right-out and one right-in/left-

in/right-out access driveway connections onto Military Trail, and; two right-in/right-out access driveway

connections onto Atlantic Ave)

Existing Uses: General Commercial = 68,413 SF

Fast Food Restaurant + DT = 4,980 SF

Proposed Uses:

Interior renovation of existing retail space

New Daily Trips:

New Peak Hour Trips: 0 AM; 0 PM

Build-out:

December 31, 2023

Based on our review, the Traffic Division has determined that the proposed project <u>meets</u> the TPS of Palm Beach County. The proposed renovation project is not expected to generate any additional traffic.

Please note the receipt of a TPS approval letter does not constitute the review and issuance of a Palm Beach County Right-of-Way (R/W) Construction Permit nor does it eliminate any requirements that may be deemed as site related. For work within Palm Beach County R/W, a detailed review of the project will be provided upon submittal for a R/W permit application. The project is required to comply with all Palm Beach County standards and may include R/W dedication.

No building permits are to be issued by the City after the build-out date specified above. The County traffic concurrency approval is subject to the Project Aggregation Rules set forth in the Traffic Performance Standards Ordinance.
