- Board direction on continuing to pursue its right to review and inspect OSSCA's records, including
 pursuant to Fla. Stat. 119.07(2)(a), to determine what records exist, and depending on the scope
 of the documentation production sought by the CRA, the CRA can make a determination after its
 inspection as to whether it wants to incur the cost and expense of proceeding with having OSSCA
 produce the responsive documents.
- Board direction on continuing to pursue FOIA request and obtaining other grant documents requested through public records requests.


