In Review

Green Building Ordinance

In Review

- In 2019 the GIAB recommended to Commission a requirement for all new development 5,000+sf to obtain LEED Certification of minimum Gold Level or equivalent
- Green Building Ordinance 30-22 passed second reading on November 1st, 2022

Ongoing and Future Priorities

- New Green Building Ordinance will go into effect November 1st, 2023
- Reevaluation of Ordinance within 2 years
- Education and outreach
