

RESOLUTION NO. 215-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA TO OBTAIN STATE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS AND TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (City) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has the statutory authority to disburse federal Homeland Security funds to participating municipalities of a Regional Domestic Security Task Force (RDSTF); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to obtain State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP) funds to offset the expenses incurred by the City to sustain and purchase specialized equipment for mitigating Hazardous Materials incidents; and

WHEREAS, by executing Federally Funded Subaward and Grant Agreements with the State, the City will have the ability to obtain reimbursement for expenses associated with the procurement and maintenance of equipment purchased through the SHSGP; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission considers it in the best interests of its residents to enter into Federally Funded Subaward and Grant Agreement to access federal disaster relief funds for the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves this Agreement between the City and the State of Florida which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit "A".

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and take any other actions necessary to effectuate this Agreement.

Section 4. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
