Site Plan:

By a 6 to 1 vote (Youngross dissenting), approved the request for a Class V site plan for the **Martini Property,** by adopting the findings of fact and law contained in the staff report, and finding that the request and approval thereof is consistent with the Comprehensive Plan and meets criteria set forth in Sections 2.4.5(F)(5), and Chapter 3 of the Land Development Regulations, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That a public access easement be recorded in a form approved by the City Attorney, on this property to provide cross access in perpetuity prior to certification of the site plan.
- 2. That a recorded deed be provided for the 2-foot alley dedication prior to certification of the site plan.

Landscape Plan:

By a 6 to 1 vote (Youngross), approved the landscape plan for the **Martini Property** based on positive findings with respect to Section 4.6.16 of the Land Development Regulations, subject to the condition that all that all Landscape Technical Items are addressed and three (3) copies of the revised plans are submitted.

Project Description:

The requests are in conjunction with the construction of a loading area and cross access to the public north-south alley from SE 4th Avenue (approximately 0.14 acres) at 59 SE 4th Avenue as conditioned in the Fourth and Fifth Delray conditional use approval.

The development proposal incorporates the following:

Demolition of the existing improvements on the property.
The construction of a loading area and a cross access driveway that provides a public connection to the north-south alley.
Installation of associated landscaping.
