Letter Of Intent

SE 2nd Street Improvements

Introduction

Work will start upon issuance of a Notice to Proceed from the City of Delray. During the course of construction traffic will be maintained to assure that local residential traffic flow smoothly and logistically for the affected residents. Coordination of “hard closures” will be made with the City. It is anticipated that the work will be completed in a “rolling” sequence with no more than two blocks closed to local traffic at one time. NPDES Maintenance for dust control will be utilized with a water truck on-site and inlet protection maintained.

Periodic “door hanger” handouts will be distributed as work progresses through the various Phases. Press releases will be coordinated with the City to assure notification to various other Public agencies such as Palm Beach County and the Florida Department of Transportation. Additionally, if deemed necessary Foster Project manager will periodically attend Neighborhood meetings prior to / and during project time to publicize the project and its impact on the neighborhood traffic flow for the specific on-going construction.

On each street segment Foster Marine will maintain access to the residences and business utilizing a temporary road surface for vehicular traffic. However, there may be times while construction is on-going in front of a specific property where vehicular access is not feasible). Coordination with individual property owners will be completed ahead of time when any of these situations occur.

Coordination for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times through the various work areas depending on the segment constructed. The “door hanger” notifications above will be published and E-mailed to City non-emergency Police/Fire dispatch to assure response time to property is not compromised.

Also, on each street segment Foster will coordinate garbage / trash pickup with City. "Door hanger" E-mails will be sent to coordinate pickup efforts based on work activity locations.

Final Milling / Overlay and Final 1" S-III Surface course on all Roadways will be installed after completion of all the Proposed Improvements are complete. Substantial Inspection will be achieved at this Point

Final thermo striping will be completed +/- 2 weeks after completion of the 1" S-III asphalt surface.

Final Completion of the Project will be achieved 120 Calendar Days or less from the Substantial Completion date.

- (b) For the purposes of this section, a person's representative shall include but not be limited to the person's employee, partner, officer, director, consultant, lobbyist, or any actual or potential subcontractor or consultant of the person.
- (c) The cone of silence shall be in effect as of the deadline to submit the proposal, bid, or other response to a competitive solicitation. The cone of silence applies to any person or person's representative who responds to a particular request for proposal, request for qualification, bid, or any other competitive solicitation, and shall remain in effect until such response is either rejected by the county or municipality as applicable or withdrawn by the person or person's representative. Each request for proposal, request for qualification, bid or any other competitive solicitation shall provide notice of cone of silence requirements and refer to this article.
- (d) The provisions of this article shall not apply to oral communications at any public proceeding, including pre-bid conferences, oral presentations before selection committees, contract negotiations during any public meeting, presentations made to the board or local municipal governing body as applicable, and protest hearings. Further, the cone of silence shall not apply to contract negotiations between any employee and the intended awardee, any dispute resolution process following the filing of a protest between the person filing the protest and any employee, or any written correspondence at any time with any employee, county commissioner, member of a local municipal governing body, mayor or chief executive officer that is not a member of the local municipal governing body, or advisory board member or selection committee member, unless specifically prohibited by the applicable competitive solicitation process.
- (e) The cone of silence shall not apply to any purchases made in an amount less than the competitive bid threshold set forth in the county purchasing ordinance (County Code, chapter 2, article III, division 2, part A, section 2-51 et seq.) or municipal ordinance as applicable.
- (f) The cone of silence shall terminate at the time the board, local municipal governing body, or a county or municipal department authorized to act on behalf of the board or local municipal governing body as applicable, awards or approves a contract, rejects all bids or responses, or otherwise takes action which ends the solicitation process.**
- (g) Any contract entered into in violation of the cone of silence provisions in this section shall render the transaction voidable.

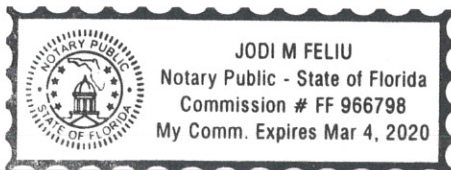
