This Service Authorization, when executed, shall be incorporated in and shall become an integral part of the "Agreement for General Consulting Engineering Services" Contract, dated February 22, 2012.

I. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

As requested by FDOT, the City of Delray Beach is making revisions to the plans / scope of project after design was performed to change from repair / replacement of brick paver pavement to new concrete pavement. FDOT would not allow replacement of existing brick paver intersections with brick pavers.

1. <u>Purpose</u>

The purpose of the project is to replace the deteriorating existing brick pavement at the intersections of East Atlantic Avenue and Gleason Street and Venetian Drive.

2. Project Area and understanding

The project area consists of the two above mentioned street intersections.

Project Understanding:

• Revise the design, construction plans and cost estimates for the two intersections at Gleason Street and Venetian Drive. Consider the new signal improvements made by FDOT. Consultant's contract expires prior to project going to construction. Therefore bidding services are limited to having the plans and specifications completed. Construction phase services are not included in the scope of the project. The SR A1A intersection will be designed by another consultant under the Beach master plan project.

General Requirements:

Consultant shall provide final design phase services in accordance with Article III.C of the Agreement for Engineering Services with the City, dated February 22, 2013.

Task 1 – Design, Plans Preparation and Permitting

- 1. Revise design and construction plans and resubmit for permitting to FDOT.
- 2. Perform concrete pavement design analysis for FDOT's approval.
- 3. Address FDOT comments.
- 4. Final concrete pavement design including texture, pattern, etc. to be approved by FDOT
- 5. Assist City in completing the maintenance agreement with FDOT (MMOA) by providing project information and plan exhibits. City staff will provide the required remaining information, execute and process the MMOA.
- 6. Submit plans to Palm Beach County Traffic Division for their acceptance regarding location of ADA ramps relative to the pedestrian signals. It is not anticipated that pedestrian signal modification would be necessary.

Phase IV – Bidding/Negotiating Phase

Consultant's contract expires prior to project going to construction phase.

<u>Phase V – Construction Administration</u>

Construction schedule was moved up to when consultant contract expires, therefore, construction phase services are not included in the scope of the project.
