The Agency is required to provide a copy of the design plans for the Department's review and approval to coordinate permitting with the Department, and notify the Department prior to commencement of any right-of-way activities.

The Agency shall commence the project's activities subsequent to the execution of this Agreement and shall perform in accordance with the following schedule:

- a) Study to be completed by N/A .
- b) Design to be completed by N/A.
- c) Right-of-Way requirements identified and provided to the Department by N/A.
- d) Right-of-Way to be certified by N/A.
- e) Construction contract to be let by 5/8/2017.
- f) Construction to be completed by 12/31/2018.

If this schedule cannot be met, the Agency will notify the Department in writing with a revised schedule or the project is subject to the withdrawal of federal funding.
