  - (a) Shall not adversely affect the neighboring area;
  - (b) Shall not significantly diminish the provision of public facilities;
  - (c) Shall not create an unsafe situation; and,
  - (d) Does not result in the grant of a special privilege in that the same waiver would be granted under similar circumstances on other property for another applicant or owner.

## A. Waiver to LDR Section 4.4.19(H)(3):

Pursuant to LDR Section 4.4.19(H)(3), overhead doors shall be prohibited from facing a public right-of-way. The development proposal includes the installation of four overhead doors along the south building elevation facing the Georgia Street right-of-way
