## RESOLUTION NO. 56-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE MAE VOLEN SENIOR CENTER FOR PROVIDING CONGREGATE MEALS FOR SENIOR CITIZENS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (City) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City provides the following services or requires the following products for the purpose of providing congregate meals for senior citizens; auditorium and kitchen facilities with storage and assignment of city staff not to exceed 25 hours per week to assist licensee in performance of this license agreement.

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with The Mae Volen Senior Center FOR providing congregate meals for senior citizens.

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

<u>Section 2.</u> The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves this Agreement between the City and The Mae Volen Senior Center, a copy of which is attached to this resolution as Exhibit A.

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute the Agreement and any amendments and/or renewals thereto, and take any other actions necessary to effectuate this Agreement.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
