CITY OF DELRAY BEACH AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO POLY PHOSPHATE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 2 to the poly phosphate supply and delivery Agreement dated July 7, 2015, by and between City of Delray Beach, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida (hereinafter referred to as "City"), and Chemrite, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party"), a Florida corporation, is entered into this _____ day of _____, 20__.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on July 7, 2015, the City entered into a two-year agreement with Second Party for the supply and delivery of poly phosphate (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, on August 23, 2017, Chemrite, Inc. acquired F2 Industries, LLC in a business acquisition; and

WHEREAS, on August 31, 2017, the City executed Amendment No. 1 to retroactively renew the Agreement through July 6, 2018. However, the City inadvertently did not address the business acquisition in Amendment No. 1; and

WHEREAS, the City determines that it is in the best interest of the City to renew the Agreement through July 6, 2019, utilizing its second and final one-year renewal option, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Second Party agrees to continue to provide services to City in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency whereof are hereby acknowledged, the parties do agree that the Agreement is amended as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein.
- 2. This Amendment No. 2 renews the Agreement, under the same terms and conditions, for the period of July 7, 2018 through July 6, 2019.
- 3. The City hereby consents to assignment of the Agreement from F2 Industries, LLC to Chemrite, Inc.
- 4. Except as provided herein, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect and are hereby confirmed. The Agreement, Amendment No. 1, and this Amendment No. 2 represent the entire understanding between the parties on the issues contained herein, either written or oral, and may only be amended by written instrument signed by both parties.
