

RESOLUTION NO. 51-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING A TRIPARTY AGREEMENT WITH THE SCHOOL BOARD OF PALM BEACH COUNTY AND COMMUNITY CHILD CARE CENTER OF DELRAY BEACH, INC. FOR FUNDING AND OPERATION OF AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS AT PINE GROVE ELEMENTARY AND VILLAGE ACADEMY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (City) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to assist the Community Child Care Center of Delray Beach (d/b/a ACCF) with the operation of after-school programs at Pine Grove Elementary and Village Academy, which are owned by the School Board of Palm Beach County; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with the Community Child Care Center of Delray Beach (d/b/a ACCF) and the School Board of Palm Beach County to provide for these programs; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves this Agreement between the School Board of Palm Beach County, Florida, the City of Delray Beach, Florida, and Community Child Care Center of Delray Beach, Inc. for Funding and Operation of Programs at Pine Grove Elementary and Village Academy, which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A.

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute the Agreement and any amendments and/or renewals thereto, and take any other actions necessary to effectuate this Agreement.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
