A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CHILDREN'S SERVICES COUNCIL OF PALM BEACH COUNTY WITH THE EARLY LEARNING COALITION OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, INC. FOR PROVIDING A SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR THE AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAM AT THE DELRAY BEACH COMMUNITY CENTER; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (City) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide scholarship program for the afterschool program at the Delray Beach Community Center; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with the Children's Services Council of Palm Beach County and the Early Learning Coaliton of Palm Beach County .to provide these services.

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves this Agreement between the City and the Children's Services Council of Palm Beach County and the Early Learning Coalition of Palm Beach County, which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A.

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute the Agreement and any amendments and/or renewals thereto, and take any other actions necessary to effectuate this Agreement.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
