A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF **ENVIRONMENTAL** PROTECTION TO OBTAIN SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FOR THE BEACH NOURISHMENT PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018/2019; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY EFFECTUATE THIS TO AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach ("City") is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City administers a Beach Nourishment Program ("Program"). As part of this Program, the City provides services such as monitoring the coastline and managing post-construction (beach nourishment) permit monitoring requirements.

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with Florida Department of Environmental Protection to obtain state grant funding for the Program for Fiscal Year 2018/2019.

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.
- Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves this Agreement between the City and Florida Department of Environmental Protection, which is attached to this resolution as Exhibit A.
- Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute the Agreement and any amendments and/or renewals thereto, and take any other actions necessary to effectuate this Agreement.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
