## RESOLUTION NO. 120-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING A PIGGY-BACK AGREEMENT WITH MERCURY ASSOCIATES, INC. TO PERFROM A COMPREHENSIVE FLEET ANALYSIS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach ("City") is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City owns approximately 550 vehicles and equipment and the Fleet Maintenance Division is responsible for the maintenance of these vehicles and equipment.

WHEREAS, the City wishes to perform a comprehensive analysis of the City's fleet management operations and development of specific recommendations to improve operational efficiencies, maximize use of available resources and position the fleet organization to become a leading provider of fleet management and maintenance and repair services.

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with Mercury Associates, Inc. utilizing an existing contract and pricing provided to the City of Boynton Beach, pursuant to its solicitation number RFP 017-2510-18/IT for Comprehensive Analysis – Fleet Operations.

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

<u>Section 2.</u> The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves this Agreement between the City and Mercury Associates, Inc. which is attached to this resolution as Exhibit A.

<u>Section 3.</u> The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute the Agreement and any amendments and/or renewals thereto, and take any other actions necessary to effectuate this Agreement.

<u>Section 4.</u> This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
