### Overview

#### Clean Program- Public Health, Safety and Welfare

- C Community- Aesthetics and pride start with well-maintained and proper use of waste and recycling container.
- L Litter- The clean program identifies overflowing bins and illegal dumping around your business that can be unsightly and negatively impact your business and community.
- E Environmental Protection- Prevent storm water run-off issues related to trash. Identify recycling opportunities to increase diversion and participation. Prevent scavenging animals.
- A Avoid overage service- A service of \$200 will be added to your invoice if the lid to your container is open 10" or more with excess material.
- Notice- Waste Management drivers use on-board computers to take digital pictures of waste on top of, surrounding, or blocking the bin. The driver will collect all material and leave the area neat and tidy. Customers will receive a notice that their trash bin was overflowing and a service overage of \$200 will be applied.

## What is the goal?

- Increase the Level Of Service
- Maintain a clean city by holding merchants accountable and responsible for litter, trash & debris
- Health, Safety and Welfare



## CURRENT OVERSIGHT

#### **Overflowing Receptacles and Litter**

- Nuisance Abatement Officers monitor 6 days a week
- Remove litter from the ground
- Bait boxes deployed Rodent Control



## Recommendations

#### **Solution**

- Immediate abatement of trash by Waste Management
- Charge merchants for overflowing receptacles and litter on the ground
- Recommend options to habitual violators; Frequency of pickups or a compactor
