### Statement of the Problem

The City of Delray Beach is located in Palm Beach County, Florida. The city has a total land area of 15.81 square miles containing 63,939 residents (United States [U.S.] Census Bureau Facts, 2015). Several major roadways pass through the city, including United States (US) Route 1, Interstate 95, and Florida State Roads A1A and 806.

In 2017, there were 3,718 crashes recorded in the City of Delray Beach which included 2 fatalities. Of those fatalities, one occupant was not properly restrained at the time of the crash. According to the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) fiscal year (FY) 2019 Highway Safety Matrix, for occupant protection-related serious injuries or fatalities, the City of Delray Beach ranked 13th out of 101 cities with populations between 15,000–74,999.

When safety belts and child restraints are properly installed and utilized, studies show that they can save lives and prevent injuries. It is clear that there is a need to increase safety belt and child restraint usage within the City of Delray Beach in order to reduce the incidences of crash-related injuries and fatalities.

### **Proposed Solution**

Delray Beach PD maintains a full-time traffic unit which has established a strong relationship with the citizens of Delray Beach. It is the sole responsibility of the traffic unit to ensure that all traffic laws and city ordinances are followed by every commuter. The Traffic Unit will conduct high visibility safety belt and child restraint enforcement in areas that have high incidences of crashes where occupants were not properly restrained. Education on Florida's occupant protection laws will also be provided during these enforcement patrols.

The Traffic unit will participate in community events to raise awareness and educate the public about the importance of utilizing safety belts and child restraints. Occupant protection-related educational material will be provided at each event. In addition, message boards, social media and press releases will be utilized to inform the public of enforcement areas in the city and to promote occupant protection messaging.
