David and Bleus (as he prefers to be called) are the Clean & Safe Electricians. They service all decorative				
light poles, outlets and handle most electrical issues on Atlantic Avenue from W 12th Avenue to A1A, one				
block north and south, NW 5th Ave	enue, NE 2 nd A	Avenue (Pineapple	Grove) and NE 4th Avenue. This also	
includes part of the marina and the	e parks within	the District. Earlier	this year, David and Bleus were	
asked to replace approximately 31 decorative light poles on E Atlantic Avenue from E 2 nd Avenue to E 5 th				
Avenue with new poles and fixtures. It should be noted that this work was previously quoted at \$78,000				
by an outside vendor due to the intensive workload and the required attention to detail. Never the ones to				
shy away from a challenge, they willingly and enthusiastically committed themselves to the task. As the				
Clean & Safe Electricians, they ar	e extremely fa	miliar with the layor	ut of the Avenue, the ebb and flow of	
pedestrian traffic, vehicular traffic	patterns, and	the high expectation	ns of their work. From February to July,	
they dedicated themselves to rem	oving two pole	es and installing two	new ones per block. They took into	
consideration weather patterns, sp	pecial events,	and the weekend c	rowds ensuring minimal negative	

impact. They also happily answered questions from residents or visitors as to the nature of their work.



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David and Bleus kept their supervisor informed of any issues, such as delays due to unforeseen
circumstances, waiting on parts or maintenance of the lift truck, which was required to complete the work.
They worked closely and communicated effectively with co-workers from the Public Works Dept who
assisted with heavy equipment operation and paver repair. Whether operating the hydraulic lift truck, drilling
into concrete or rewiring fixtures, David and Bleus utilized best safety practices to protect themselves
and the public. Their high work ethic and standards, in addition to their care for the Clean & Safe District,
produced a recognizable quality work product throughout and after the project's completion. As an added
bonus to their work product, their cost portion of this project is estimated at \$8,000 - an incredible
savings to the City!
