

RESOLUTION NO. 17-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA ENDORSING THE COMPLETE CLOSURE OF THE BRANT DRIVE BRIDGE DURING THE BRANT DRIVE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT BY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (hereinafter referred to as the “City”) wishes to reconstruct the Brant Drive Bridge from Oregon Lane, located in the City of Boca Raton, to Avocet Road, located in the City of Delray Beach; and

WHEREAS, the City currently maintains the existing bridge and will continue to maintain the bridge after construction has been completed; and

WHEREAS, the City approved Resolution 04-18 endorsing the State of Florida Department of Transportation (hereinafter referred to as “FDOT”) for the reconstruction of the Brant Drive Bridge; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes this Bridge will be replaced and there will be a complete road and bridge closure during the entire duration of the construction project, and pedestrian and vehicular traffic will need to be detoured to other City Streets; and

WHEREAS, the FDOT will submit complete roadway closure plans for the project which will be reviewed and approved by the City Engineer prior to implementation; and

WHEREAS, through this Resolution 17-19, the FDOT will implement the roadway closures during the construction of the project, which is expected to last nine months to one year beginning April 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that execution of Resolution 17-19 to be in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the City of Delray Beach; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to take any actions necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
