

RESOLUTION NO. 53-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY
BEACH, FLORIDA ADOPTING AN UPDATE OF
THE CITY'S STORMWATER MASTER PLAN
COMPLETED BY ADA ENGINEERING.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach ("City") has not updated the City's Stormwater Master Plan since 2001.

WHEREAS, the City has been experiencing impacts of climate change for several years including tidal flooding of City streets;

WHEREAS, the City Commission has chosen to prioritize adapting to climate change impacts by implementing recommendations from the City's updated Stormwater Master Plan.

WHEREAS, the City Commission has chosen to adopt the Stormwater Master Plan Update to lower the Community Rating System (CRS) rating in order to lower homeowner's insurance for City residents.

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves adopting the Stormwater Master Plan update.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
