## RESOLUTION NO. 60-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, REPEALING RESOLUTION 150-18; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Delray Beach (hereinafter referred to as the "Commission") passed Resolution 150-18 on December 11, 2018 determining that a levy of a non-ad valorem assessment was needed to fund a portion of the cost of fire protection services within the incorporated area of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Commission finds that it is necessary to repeal Resolution 150-18; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that approval of this Resolution is in the best interests of the public and the citizens of Delray Beach.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. That Resolution 150-18 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. Upon adoption, the City Clerk is hereby directed to send a copy of this Resolution by United States mail to the Florida Department of Revenue, the Palm Beach County Tax Collector, and the Palm Beach County Property Appraiser.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
