WHEREAS, the City is the owner of the following-described real property:

A parcel of land 15 feet in width located in Block 134 as shown on Plat of original Town of Linton as recorded in Plat Book 1 at Page 3, Palm Beach County, Florida, Public Records and more particularly described as follows:

The North 15 feet of the South 39 feet of Block 134, as shown on Plat of original Town of Linton as recorded in Plat Book 1 at Page 3, Palm Beach County, Florida, Public Records, as measured at right angles to the Easterly extension of the South line of Lot 7, of Subdivision of Block 126, as recorded in Plat Book 11, Page 4, Palm Beach County, Florida, Public Records; said 15-foot easement lying between the East line of said Lot 7 of Block 126 and West right-of-way line of the Intracoastal Waterway, said 15-foot easement for ingress and egress across City property to a street known as Marine Way (the "Servient Land");
