A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING AGREEMENT THE **FLORIDA** AN WITH DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) FOR THE LOCAL AGENCY PROGRAM (LAP) SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 6 TIME EXTENSION REQUEST FOR NE 2ND AVE / SEACREST BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (City) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City entered an Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) on March 24, 2015, for widening, landscaping, pedestrian lighting, and crosswalks on NE 2nd Avenue from NE 4th Street to George Bush Boulevard (Seacrest Beautification Project); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement requires the City to complete the Seacrest Beautification Project by June 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City desires additional time to complete the Seacrest Beautification Project; and

WHEREAS, FDOT, under LAP Supplemental Agreement No. 6, will provide an additional 6-month time extension to December 31, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves the Local Agency Program Supplemental Agreement between the City and FDOT, which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit "A".

<u>Section 3.</u> The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute the Agreement and any amendments and/or renewals thereto and take any other actions necessary to effectuate this Agreement.

<u>Section 4</u>. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
