

Pine Island Ridge Country Club — Prior to the development of the existing golf course in the early 1970s, the site and surrounding area were covered with citrus groves. GFA performed extensive assessment of pesticides, herbicides, and arsenic from 2010 until 2012. Concentrations of arsenic detected in soil and groundwater were identified in excess of State of Florida Soil and Groundwater Cleanup Target Levels. Following approval of the Site Assessment Report, one (1) 'year of post-site assessment groundwater monitoring was conducted. Broward County Pollution Prevention, Remediation and Air Quality Division (PPRAQD) approved a request for No Further Actions with Conditions (NFAC), according to Risk-Based Management Option III. A Draft of Restrictive Covenant containing institutional and engineering controls is currently being reviewed by PPRAQD.

Boca Raton Resort & Club — This large facility combines hotel and residential space, recreational facilities, a marina, conference center, and support buildings. During the foundation construction of a new marina wing, drycleaning solvent contamination associated with the laundry building facility was discovered. A contamination assessment was performed which included the installation of monitoring wells in sensitive and limited-access areas without disturbing facility operations. A bioremediation agent was injected into the chlorinated solvent plume as part of active remediation efforts. Significant contaminate concentration reductions were observed during a year of


post active remediation monitoring. Semi-annual groundwater monitoring continues to be conducted at Boca Resort and site closure is anticipated in approximately 1-2 years.

Lake Point Restoration Mine — Performs exploratory soil and groundwater assessment, monthly mine pit monitoring, quarterly and annual groundwater monitoring, data analysis, and reporting. The activities are conducted in accordance with Lake Point's Environmental Resource Permit (ERP) for the operation of a limestone aggregate mine. An Acquisition and Development Agreement for Public Works Project between the landowners and the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) will result in the creation and donation of 1,800 acres of water management, water quality treatment and transfer areas, and the donation of approximately 172 acres of conservation lands for public recreational uses. The mining activities and environmental monitoring are regulated by the FDEP's Bureau of Mining and Minerals Regulation.

Mizner Lakes — The Mizner Lakes property was utilized as a baseball training facility from circa 1967 to 1997. Herbicides containing arsenic were used to maintain playing fields during the operational use of the site. Approximately 643 tons of soil impacted with arsenic in excess of the Residential Soil Cleanup Target Level were excavated and removed from the subject property. Following initial remedial actions, vertical and horizontal delineation of both soil and groundwater contamination was achieved. A closure process is currently being negotiated with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) to reach No Further Action (NFA) with institutional controls.

Broward County Courthouse Main Parking Facility – This property operated as a Coca-Cola Distribution facility in the 1930s and 1940s. During construction of the new Broward County Courthouse Main Parking Garage, a total of five (5) unregistered Underground Storage Tanks (USTs) were discovered. A total of 340 tons of petroleum-impacted soils were excavated, temporarily stockpiled onsite, and disposed at Waste Management's Monarch Hill Landfill in Pompano Beach, Florida.
