A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF PURCHASE ORDERS ΤO UTILIZE THE FLORIDA SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION CONTRACT FOR VEHICLE PURCHASES; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY ΤO EFFECTUATE ACTIONS THIS AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach ("City") is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase two (2) Ford Interceptors for use by the City's Police Department; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with solicitation number FSA19 VEL-27.0, the Florida Sheriff's entered into a cooperative purchasing program agreement effective October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020, for various police vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase two (2) Ford Interceptors utilizing the same terms, conditions, and pricing provided under solicitation number FSA19 VEL-27.0; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

<u>Section 2.</u> The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves the issuance of purchase orders for the purchase of two (2) Ford Police Interceptors utilizing the Florida Sheriff's Association Contract No. FSA19 VEL-27.0.

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to take any action necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

<u>Section 4.</u> This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
