Johnson is re-elected as Commission Member/Seat #4 for three year terms commencing on the 31st day of March, 2020, and ending in accordance with the Charter. Also, the results of the referendum question posed to Delray Beach voters as to whether the Charter Amendment should be adopted for salary increases of the Mayor and Commissioners each year.

City Clerk Johnson read the official results from the March 17, 2020 First Nonpartisan Election into the record for Commission Member/Seat #2 and Commission Member/Seat #4; including all regular, absentee, and provisional votes as ascertained by the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections, and that it is hereby declared, based upon the foregoing results,

that Juli Casale is elected as Commission Member/Seat #2 and Shirley E. Johnson is re-elected as Commission Member/Seat #4 for three year terms commencing on the 31st day of March, 2020, and ending in accordance with the Charter.
