

Requests from Business/Non-Profit Group for Phase 1 Re-Opening of Delray Beach

- 1) Would like parking to remain free, but would like parking enforcement to occur so that parking spaces are turned over (keep the time limits but keep it free).
- 2) Would like the creation of parklets for restaurants (i.e., put up barricades between the on-street parking spaces and lanes of travel, and create a parklet type seating area to allow for tables and chairs in the parking spot and/or retail displays). Would like the City/CRA to fund the cost for the parklet set up.
- 3) Would like Old School Square Park to be designated an area for outdoor picnicking with tables and chairs and/or benches that are cleaned and maintained by the City/CRA. Would not like tents. Would be open to the benches that the City uses at the holidays.
- 4) Would like permission for an alternate location for the Summer Green Market if Old School Square Park is approved for use for picnicking during Phase 1.
- 5) Would recommend that valet parking services be re-opened.
- 6) Would recommend that valet queue fees be reduced while business capacity is reduced (i.e., while restaurants and retail are at lowered permitted capacity).
- 6) Would like the City/CRA to set up and maintain hand sanitizing and hand washing stations on Atlantic Avenue and in parks where people will congregate such as Old School Square Park.
- 7) Would like the Commission to close Atlantic Avenue to vehicles on Saturdays.
- 8) Would like the City to establish testing sites for employees of Delray businesses so that the employees can get free COVID-19 tests.
- 9) Would like the Freebee Transportation to be re-opened for operation.
