RESOLUTION NO. 77-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (FDEM) TO OBTAIN FEDERAL DISASTER RECOVERY FUNDS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS AND TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (City) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Emergency Management ("FDEM") has the statutory authority to disburse federal disaster recovery funds received in response to Hurricane Dorian; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to obtain federal disaster recovery funds to offset the expenses incurred in responding to Hurricane Dorian and for damages sustained to City property; and

WHEREAS, by executing Federally Funded Subaward and Grant Agreements with FDEM the City will have the ability to access disaster relief funds provided by the Federal Government; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission considers it in the best interests of its residents to enter into Federally Funded Subaward and Grant Agreements with FDEM, to access federal disaster relief funds for the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves this Agreement between the City and the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A.

<u>Section 3</u>. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and take any other actions necessary to effectuate these Agreements.

Section 4. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
