

RESOLUTION NO 88-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA STATEWIDE READINESS PROVIDER; THE EARLY LEARNING COALITION OF PALM BEACH COUNTY FOR THE SCHOOL READINESS PROGRAM FOR THE AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAMS AT THE POMPEY PARK COMMUNITY CENTER AND THE DELARY BEACH COMMUNITY CENTER; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS AND/OR RENEWALS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (City) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide a scholarship program for the afterschool program at the Pompey Park Community Center and Delray Beach Community Center; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with the Early Learning Coalition of Palm Beach County to provide these services.

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves this Agreement between the Early Learning Coalition of Palm Beach County, which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A.

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and/or renewals thereto and take any other actions necessary to effectuate this Agreement.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
