## **RESOLUTION NO. 139-20 - HURRICANE ISAIAS**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, TERMINATING THE STATE OF EMERGENCY PREVIOUSLY DECLARED IN RESPONSE TO HURRICANE ISAIAS PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 95 OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on July 31, 2020, Interim City Manager Jennifer Alvarez declared a State of Emergency in response to Executive Orders issued by Palm Beach County and Governor Ron Desantis concerning Hurricane Isaias;

WHEREAS, Hurricane Isaias has passed, and the City has completed its recovery efforts;

WHEREAS, a State of Emergency no longer exists in the City of Delray Beach; and

WHEREAS, Interim City Manager Jennifer Alvarez, as the official who declared the emergency, does hereby deactivate the City's Emergency Management system and in accordance with Chapter 95 of the City of Delray Beach Code of Ordinances does hereby terminate the previously declared State of Emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> The State of Emergency previously proclaimed on July 31, 2020 within the City of Delray Beach, Florida is hereby terminated.

<u>Section 2.</u> The City Manager, or designee, is hereby directed to reinstate normal operations and procedures for all City operations and business as a State of Emergency no longer exists.
