This concerns the Planning & Zoning item that came before the Delray Beach Downtown Development Authority at the July 13, 2020 board meeting.

ITEM- Doc's Place - Future Land Use Map Amendment 220-138, Rezoning & LDR Amendments 2020-137

Discussion ensued regarding the office use proposed, the increase in density and the importance of preserving the existing Doc's building.

ACTION – Motion to deny the Doc's Place - Future Land Use Map Amendment 220-138, Rezoning & LDR Amendments 2020-137 as presented. Motion: M. Benson 2<sup>nd</sup>: A. Zeller 3-4. Motion does not pass.

ACTION – Motion to approve the Doc's Place - Future Land Use Map Amendment 220-138, Rezoning & LDR Amendments 2020-137 as presented with the contingency of Doc's building to be preserved.

Motion: J. Conde 2<sup>nd</sup>: P. Ramsey Motion withdrawn.

ACTION – Motion to approve the Doc's Place - Future Land Use Map Amendment 220-138, Rezoning & LDR Amendments 2020-137 as presented with the contingency of Doc's building to be preserved as a contributing structure in the Historic District.

Motion: J. Conde Motion withdrawn.

ACTION – Motion to approve the Doc's Place - Future Land Use Map Amendment 220-138, Rezoning & LDR Amendments 2020-137 as presented with the following contingencies: Doc's building to be preserved as a contributing structure in the Historic District; the ground floor to be reserved only for retail uses; and to include other façade architectural styles in the Future Project Plan to be presented before the Site Plan Review and Appearance Board and before the City Commission Board.
