

RESOLUTION NO. 24-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, RATIFYING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH PALM BEACH COUNTY TO OBTAIN FEDERAL FUNDS UNDER THE CARES ACT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS AND TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS AGREEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (City) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, Palm Beach County, a Political Subdivision of the State of Florida (County) has the statutory authority to disburse federal disaster recovery funds received in response to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to obtain federal disaster recovery funds to offset the expenses incurred by the City in responding to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, by executing an Interlocal Agreement with the County the City will have the ability to access disaster relief funds provided by the Federal Government; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves and ratifies this Agreement between the City of Delray Beach and Palm Beach County which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit "A".

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute any amendments and take any other actions necessary to effectuate this Agreement.

Section 4. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
