In order to address the school capacity deficiency generated by this proposed development at the District high school level, the property owner shall contribute \$27,242 to the School District of Palm Beach County prior to the issuance of first building permit. This school capacity contribution is intended to supplement the required school impact fee (impact fee credit has already been applied).
