A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AGREEMENTS WITH ABSOLUTE ENGINEERING CIVIL SOLUTIONS, LLC, C.A.P GOVERNMENT, INC., GFA INTERNATIONAL, INC., AND MT CAUSLEY, LLC FOR INSPECTION, PLAN REVIEW AND DEVELOPMENT REVIEW SERVICES; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AMENDMENTS AND/OR RENEWALS AND TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE AGREEMENTS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves the Agreements between the City and Absolute Civil Engineering Solutions, LLC (attached hereto as Exhibit "A"), C.A.P Government, Inc. (attached hereto as Exhibit "B")., GFA International, Inc. (attached hereto as Exhibit "C"), and MT Causley, LLC (attached hereto as Exhibit "D").
