

RESOLUTION NO. 71-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF A PURCHASE ORDER FOR THE PURCHASE OF A PIERCE ENFORCER FIRE APPARATUS TO UTILIZE THE FLORIDA SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION CONTRACT FOR VEHICLE PURCHASES; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach ("City") is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase a Pierce Enforcer fire apparatus for use by the City's Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with solicitation number FSA20-VEF14.02, the Florida Sheriff Association entered into a cooperative purchasing program agreement effective May 1, 2020, through March 31, 2023, for various police vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase a Pierce Enforcer fire apparatus utilizing the same terms, conditions, and pricing provided under solicitation number FSA20-VEF14.02; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Delray Beach has reviewed and hereby approves the issuance of a purchase order for the purchase of a Pierce Enforcer fire apparatus utilizing the Florida Sheriff's Association Contract No. FSA20-VEF14.02.

Section 3. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to take any action necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
