
Item before the Board:

The item before the board is a color change from Tangerine to a Breathe of Fresh Air.

Analysis:

The Grand Bahama Office Building was built in 2004 and consists of 14 buildings. In 2019, Building L came in for a color change from a Ansonic Peach to a Jack and the Bean Stalk. The remainder of the buildings within the professional complex are in light blue, light yellow, and peach.

The color change proposal consists of the body being painted "Breathe of Fresh Air" and the awnings and roof remaining as is.
