ITEM – 615 E. Atlantic Avenue – Atlantic Crossing Master Sign Program Phase One

Dear Board Members:

This concerns the Planning & Zoning item, 615 E. Atlantic Avenue – Atlantic Crossing Master Sign Program Phase One, which came before the Delray Beach Downtown Development Authority at the September 13, 2021 Board meeting. Ensued discussion regarding why this particular project is allowed to apply for a waiver for the size of the signage, while all the projects that came forward, previously, were required to fulfill the LDR's rules on this matter. Discussion on the size and amount of signs allowed throughout the project, along with the proximity to residential areas. It is the DDA Board consensus that all businesses should follow the same rules as per signage, so that it meets and blends into the fabric of the Downtown area streetscape.
