

RESOLUTION 146-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH FLORIDA MUNICIPAL INSURANCE TRUST FOR PROPERTY, EXCESS LIABILITY AND EXCESS WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Delray Beach (City) is authorized to enter into agreements to provide services, programming and products in accordance with its Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to renew its property, excess liability and excess workers' compensation insurance; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with Florida Municipal Insurance Trust ("FMIT"); and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems approval of this resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Delray Beach and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELRAY BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute the agreement with Florida Municipal Insurance Trust and take any other actions necessary to effectuate the agreement with FMIT.

Section 4. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
